



## Off-licence

### Sections 17, 19 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

67/OFF/8/2026

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **GRASSHOPPER ROCK WINE LIMITED**, is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at 244 Earnsclough Road, Alexandra and known as Grasshopper Rock, to any person for consumption off the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

#### Tastings

The licensee is authorised to sell and supply grape wine (or to supply it for free), as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
  - (i) on the premises; or
  - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 8.00pm**
- d) Alcohol may only be delivered Monday to Sunday between the hours of 6.00am and 11.00pm.
- e) Tasting samples sold on the premises must contain no more than 35 millilitres of wine.
- f) The licensee must ensure that, at all times the premises is open for the sale of grape wine for tasting on the premises, a reasonable range of snack food is available for sale and consumption at the winery cellar door, at reasonable prices and within a reasonable time of being ordered.
- g) Drinking water must be freely available to customers at the cellar door while alcohol is being supplied free or sold, as a sample, on the premises.
- h) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- i) Order forms for mail or internet orders must require the buyer and the prospective receiver to declare that they are 18 years of age or over.
- j) A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises.

#### Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- Until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire until the close of the period 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

Expiry date being **3 February 2029** unless renewed for a further period.
